1. What are the central ideas, problems and/or questions that inform the focus for your Bachelor of Arts?
2. What two disciplines do you need to focus on to help you understand those ideas, address those problems and answer the questions at issue?
3. What is your current understanding of a holistic and integrative approach to learning?
4. How does your life experience and undergraduate education so far prepare you for work in Interdisciplinary Studies?
5. How do you envision employing your interdisciplinary education after completing your BA at Naropa?
6. What have you recently read and how is it relevant to your proposed BA Interdisciplinary Studies program?
