Our students examine who they are, their roles in the world, and how they want to meet the world and change it for the better. In a minimum of one page, please tell us about a transformational experience you have had and how it enhanced your ability to see another person's view, alter your own view, or engage with the issue or your community in a new way.

**Supplemental Application for Transfers:** If applying with 30 or more semester credits to the Environmental Studies, Interdisciplinary Studies, Music, Visual Arts, Writing and Literature, or the BFA in Performance program, you must complete a department-specific supplemental application.
