This way you will be prompted to log in with your Naropa network username and password to access resources to which we subscribe, so to gain the fullest access possible to materials.

Access our **Ebscohost E-Book collection** here:

Then click on the link for the **Ebscohost E-Book Collection**. You will be prompted to log in with your Naropa network username and password. Once you log in, you will be able to access the electronic book collection.

One nice thing about electronic books is that you can search the text of the book for a word or phrase. To take advantage of this, click on the hyperlinked title that is of interest to you, then click on the PDF or EPUB full text of the book to the left of the screen. You can then access the options for utilizing the book that appear above the text of the book, toward the top of the screen and to the left. One of the options is “search within” option. Click on this option; you will get a search field in which you can type in any word or phrase.

You can also save pages, chapters, or a portion of the book; just click on Save Pages, and then choose what you would like to save. For each book, there will be a limit to what you can save, based on certain rights that are unique to each book publisher.

Naropa Libraries offers access to several online periodical indexes of abstracts, journals, and other research databases, many with full-text access to materials.

Open the drop down menu for **Finding Articles**, then select **Research Databases**. Databases are organized by discipline, and also lower down you will see that they are organized in an alphabetical list for your convenience. You will use your MyNaropa username and password to access the database or journal of your choice; after clicking on a title, you will be prompted to log in with your Naropa network information.

Online Journal Locator

Click on **Finding Articles**, then **Online Journal Locator**. You can type in or copy & paste the name of any journal title to see if we have access to it through our online resources. Once again, if online access is provided, then you will be prompted to log in with your Naropa network information when you click on the title.
