

# Study Abroad Credits through Naropa University

Thinking of studying abroad but curious how it might fit into your degree plan at Naropa? The following is a curriculum map showing courses offered through Naropa’s various study abroad and how they might fit into your degree requirements. The following isn’t an exhaustive list but gives you an idea of how courses land within core and major requirements for each of Naropa’s study abroad or gap year options. ## Bhutan Study Abroad Program

- BSA350 Guided Independent Research: Bhutan does not count towards a student’s maximum number of Independent Study credits.
- All RUB courses count towards the 6-credit maximum transfer credits allowed to count towards major requirements.
