### Naropa University Disclosure

*Notice to students pursuing the Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program, which may lead to a professional license or certification required for employment.*

Naropa's Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program may lead to a professional license or certification that is required for employment. Professional licensure/certification requirements vary from state to state, which may affect a student's ability to secure a professional license/certification upon the completion of the program. The U.S. Department of Education regulation 34 CFR 668.43(a)(5)(v) requires an institution to disclose whether the program will fulfill educational requirements for licensure or certification for each state.

The Naropa University education combines rigorous academic learning with contemplative practice. All concentrations of our Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program are currently CACREP equivalent, but not CACREP accredited. This means that we teach all of the core components that are required by CACREP to be a Clinical Mental Health Counselor, in addition to leading edge contemplative, mindfulness and mind/body integration tools.

If you are a graduating student, we strongly encourage you to start the process of applying for professional licensure in the state you intend to practice prior to leaving Naropa. Begin by reaching out to your concentration area advisor who can connect you to a Naropa team member that provides credentialing and licensure support for your initial application.

The following states have additional requirements for licensure or certification as a Clinical Mental Health Counselor, and Naropa's curriculum does not meet the state educational requirements in the following states. You will need to check your specific concentration course requirements to confirm that your courses have met the requirements for licensure or certification in your state. We recommend students contact the appropriate state licensing agency in their state or the state where they intend to work to seek the most up-to-date information about state licensure/certification requirements before beginning the program. Please note that Naropa is not accepting applicants currently residing in or intending to practice in Florida, Kentucky, Ohio, North Carolina, and New Hampshire because those states require a degree from a CACREP accredited university. Naropa is CACREP equivalent, but not CACREP accredited. Therefore, a degree from Naropa will not meet the educational requirements for licensure/certification in those states.
